- BPWD2107 Ion exchange Adams Ave. PRI started excavation for the brine/hydrogen peroxide tank slabs. Plumber is still working on ISEP small piping. Start-up scheduled for mid-February. Air stripper delivery is scheduled for January 21, 2025.
- 3. BPWD2472 AT&T upgrades at Adams Ave tank. Construction of antenna upgrades should be completed by the end of next week.
- BPWD2301 Renovation of administration building, the tile will start next week. HVAC, electrical and general contractors are still on site finishing up items.
- 5. BPWD2403 New garage at Grumman Road. Commissioner Greco stated that this project will be on hold for the time being. However, he would like a motorized gate installed at the site.
