Permission is hereby granted to _____
to draw water for _____
within the Bethpage Water District for the year ending on December 31, 20____.
The District reserves the right to prohibit the use of certain hydrants at its discretion as follows:

Water sold through hydrant connection or through any temporary connection for use in container vehicles, i.e. spray truck, municipal road sweepers, etc., shall be by permit only. Permits shall be granted by the District for an annual charge of THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) per company or municipality with one vehicle. Each additional vehicle, per company or municipality, shall be charged THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) per vehicle, annually. The unauthorized use of water from District hydrants shall constitute as a violation of Section 7.1 of the Ordinances of BWD and the violator shall be fined the sum of SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$600.00) for each such violation.

\$300.00 CASH Deposit for Storz Blind Cap and wrench required upon return of the cap the deposit will be returned.

Use of fire hydrants is subject to the priority of the Fire Department. All appurtenances and connections must be removed immediately in the event a hydrant is required for any firematic purpose. Use of hydrant must be discontinued where there is a fire at any location in the area so full operating pressures may be maintained during the fire.

Service under this permit is limited to periods of normal demand and the District reserves the right to refuse service during periods of peak demands. Connection to any hydrant may be by means of any approved air-gap equal to three (3) pipe diameters or by means of a proper adapter and reducer fitted with a 1 ½" gate valve (or equal) and New York State approved reduced pressure backflow prevention device to which the hose will be connected. Hydrants are to be opened to their full capacity and the flow controlled by the 1 ½" valve. All equipment is to be available for inspection by the District personnel. Hydrants are to be opened and used with care and with standard hydrant wrenches only. Any evidence of damage is to be reported to the District immediately.

A copy of this permit is to be carried at all times.
